Dear Supporters:

I am pleased to announce that the 2023 Operation Reveille has been scheduled for Tuesday, September 12, 2023, from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm at the Salvation Army's KROC Center. Operation Reveille shifts from the old Stand Down model to a housing and employment focused event. Operation Reveille is one part of the many efforts we use to reach out and provide services to homeless Veterans.

At the event, the Atlanta VA Healthcare System will provide services and resources to homeless Veterans such as Housing Eligibility, Triage, Barbers, Housing Resource Matching, and Vocational Opportunities. Veterans needing intensive treatment services will be properly referred.

Operation Reveille is a collaborative event coordinated between the Atlanta VA, other government agencies, Veterans Service Organizations, and Community Partners that serve homeless Veterans. The 2023 Operation Reveille is a key component to the VA's 2023 mission:


1. Permanently house at least 38,000 Veterans experiencing homelessness.
2. Ensure that at least 95% of the Veterans housed in 2023 do not return to homelessness this year; and of those who return to homelessness, ensure that at least 90% are rehoused or on a path to rehousing by the end of 2023.
3. Engage with at least 28,000 unsheltered Veterans to help them obtain housing and other wraparound services. This represents a more than 10% increase in the number of unsheltered Veterans reached during CY 2022.

In order to provide our homeless Veterans with the support they need, we are reaching out to our strong network of supporters. We are hoping you will once again answer the call to serve by joining dedicated individuals throughout our community for this year's Operation Reveille, formally known as the Homeless Stand Down.
